ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER S-2024-054 (Rescinds Administrative Order S-2018-018)

RESCISSION OF ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER S-2018-018 (RELEASE OF PRETRIAL DETAINEES UPON HURRICANE WARNING)

Administrative Order S-2018-018 was entered more than six years ago to authorize the Hillsborough County Sheriff to release certain pretrial detainees whenever a hurricane warning was issued for Hillsborough County. Since Administrative Order S-2018-018 was entered, the Florida Legislature amended sections 903.011 and 907.041, Florida Statutes – relating to pretrial release and pretrial detention – and these statutory provisions are no longer consistent with the provisions of Administrative Order S-2018-018.

By the power vested in the chief judge under article V, section 2(d), Florida Constitution; section 43.26, Florida Statutes, and Florida Rule of General Practice and Judicial Administration 2.215(b)(2), it is therefore ORDERED:

Administrative Order S-2018-018 is rescinded effective immediately.
